Production Parallel Testing Period

The CA Web production parallel testing period for Reorganizations lifecycle functionality is targeted to begin on July 31, 2018. The parallel testing period will run for approximately six months, until early Q1 2019. During that time, clients will continue to have access to all PTS/PBS functions for Reorganization events (RIPS, SDAR Dept. C and ADJI) as well as to the corresponding functionality on CA Web.

The purpose of the parallel testing period is to give clients the opportunity to familiarize themselves with CA Web reorganizations navigation for the full processing lifecycle, and reconcile the data and screens to PTS/PBS. Clients should expect that enhancements will be deployed during this period as needed and should report any findings to catransformation@dtcc.com. Substantive enhancements will be communicated via Important Notice.

Clients are encouraged to participate in parallel testing in order to ensure they will be able to conduct business using CA Web once PTS/PBS functions supporting reorganization events are retired in Q1 2019.

Affected PTS/PBS Functions

At the end of the test period in Q1 2019, these PTS/PBS functions will no longer be available for new activity, however, they will be available for historical research purposes.

CA Web Access of Reorganizations Functionality

Beginning on July 31, 2018, the following new CA Web Reorganizations functionality will be available to all clients:

- Dashboard includes Custody Reorg, Reorg Deposits
- Entitlements
- Allocations
- Adjustments

To access CA Web and its Reorganization functionality, all users must be provisioned by their Super Access Coordinator (SAC) or Access Coordinator (AC) with appropriate roles. Note that no action is required for users who already have the roles detailed below for Dashboard, Entitlements, Allocations and Adjustments for Distributions and/or Redemptions event types, as those roles will enable access to Reorganization events as well.

DTC has posted a helpful guide on the learning center for SACs and ACs requiring a refresher on how to provision CA Web user IDs and roles. For direct access to the guide, click here. If you do not have a learning center log on ID, see the Training Plan section of this notice for instructions.

Availability of Reorganization Announcements in CA Web

During the week of July 9, 2018, DTC will make Reorganization Announcements available to all CA Web users who don't currently have access to them. At that time, users already provisioned with the "Customer DTC" or "Customer Admin DTC" role will automatically be able to view the Reorganizations announcements and search for reorg events using the event search functionality. Those who do not have one of the aforementioned roles should request it from their SAC or AC if they wish to have access to Reorg Announcements.

Note that clients must continue to use PTS/PBS for input of Reorganization instructions as this functionality has not been developed for CA Web. The PTS/PBS instructions processors are detailed below:


Training Plan

To prepare for the transition to CA Web, we suggest that clients focus on the Corporate Actions "Learning Path" section of the Learning Center. Clients can access the Learning Center at https://dtcclearning.com/

To register for the Asset Services Learning Center:

- 2. On the upper right hand side of the page, click LOGIN OR REGISTER

- You will receive an email from DTCC acknowledging your registration request. A subsequent email will follow within one business day confirming approval of your registration.

Once logged in, click on "CA Learning Path" from the Corporate Actions menu. (See screenshot below.) Training videos detailing CA Web Reorganizations functionality will be available in July 2018. DTC will also offer live instructor led Q&A review sessions via webinar, beginning in July 2018. Session dates will be announced in a future Important Notice.

- June 2018 through Q1 2019: Attend DTC hosted monthly industry calls to stay informed of developments arising from parallel testing as well as key deadlines
 - Registration details and agendas for the calls are sent monthly to individuals on the Corporate Actions Transformation distribution list. If you haven't already added your name to the list and would like to receive invitations to the calls, email <u>catransformation@dtcc.com</u>. If you previously received an invitation for an industry call, your name is already on the distribution list. Registration is required for each monthly call.
