Subject:	Submission of Rule Filing SR-FICC-2020-014 – Amend the GSD Rules and MBSD Rules to Modify the Clearing Fund Maintenance Fee, Reduce the End of Day Position Fee of GSD, and Describe FICC's Current Rebate Policy

On November 16, 2020, Fixed Income Clearing Corporation ("FICC") filed a proposed rule change (SR-FICC-2020-014) ("Rule Filing") with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended. The purpose of the Rule Filing is amend FICC's Mortgage-Backed Securities Division ("MBSD") Clearing Rules ("MBSD Rules") and Government Securities Division ("GSD") Rulebook ("GSD Rules") to: (i) modify the respective Clearing Fund Maintenance Fee of GSD and MBSD, (ii) reduce the end of day position fee of GSD, and (iii) include a description of FICC's current policy regarding the issuance of rebates to GSD Members and MBSD Clearing Members.
