Subject:	New Requirement for Announcement Detail Submission to DTC

Today, DTC receives announcement detail three different ways: (i) documentation via email, (ii) automated DCN/BMA/REDCal¹ files, or (iii) a standardized DCN/BMA/REDCal spreadsheet format via email (known as "Lite Files"). On September 28, 2023, DTC's Operational Arrangement was amended to require Agents to send announcement detail *only* by way of:

- (i) Automated DCN/BMA/REDCAL files, or
- (ii) Standardized Lite Files

Effective July 1, 2024, DTC will no longer accept announcement notifications sent outside of the required formats specified in the Operational Arrangement. As a result, agents should review the documentation on DTCC's website to obtain the user guides and templates for the standardized Lite Files.
