Subject: Final Reminder Regarding the Implementation of the Confirmation of an OFAC Program SR-DTC-2009-14

On October 1, 2009, The Depository Trust Company notified Participants and Pledges of their obligation to provide DTC with a "Confirmation of an OFAC Program" letter (hereinafter, "the OFAC Letter"). For more information, please refer to rule filing SR-DTC-2009-14 and [Important Notice B5707-09](#), available at www.dtcc.com.

This Important Notice serves as a final reminder that the OFAC Compliance Officer, Chief Compliance Officer or other individual with responsibility for managing the OFAC compliance program for Participants and Pledges must return a validly executed OFAC Letter to DTC **no later than March 31, 2010**. The OFAC Letter is available via the Legal & Regulatory portion of DTCC's website at <http://www.dtcc.com/legal/compliance/>. Electronic versions of the executed OFAC Letter should be returned to DTC's email address established specifically for this purpose, which is OFAC_Certification@dtcc.com. As previously indicated, Participants or Pledges who fail to provide a validly executed OFAC Letter to FICC on or before March 31, 2010 will be subject to a \$5,000 fine. A validly executed letter must contain, among other things, an authorized signature, the signor's title, the date signed, the company's letter head, the Participant or Pledgee name in the body of the letter, and no alterations to the language of the letter. In an effort to ensure that you meet the March 31st deadline, please allow sufficient time for delivery as well as the opportunity to correct inadvertent omissions and errors.
