DTCC will be hosting a series of monthly industry calls to engage and inform the DTC Participant community of key deadlines and important topics pertaining to the Corporate Actions Transformation initiative.

The series began in July and will be held monthly through the end of the year.

Topics covered will include information related to the three client pillars of the initiative:

- New Data Model aligned with market practice replaces DTC’s proprietary function-code data model
- New Corporate Actions web browser – CA Web – replaces PTS and PBS
- New ISO 20022 messages replace CCF files

A demo of the new CA Web browser will also be provided. There is a mandatory migration for all Participants from PTS/PBS to CA Web for Distributions announcements and processing in June 2014. The following ten functions will be retired and will no longer available for use in PTS/PBS for Distributions events:

- EDS, DIVA, DAWN, SDAR, DPAL, PIAR, ADJI, DUEB, TAXI, BOOK

Upcoming Deadlines
<b>June 2014 – PTS/PBS is retired for <u>Distributions</u> events</b>
PTS/PBS corporate actions applications EDS, DIVA, SDAR, DAWN, DPAL, ADJI, PIAR, DUEB, BOOK and TAXI will be retired for Distributions events in <b>June 2014</b> and all Participants are required to transition to the new corporate actions browser – CA Web.
<b>December 2015 – CCF files are retired for <u>all Announcements</u></b>
All CCF corporate actions announcements files – including DIVANN, CMORT, REDEMA, REDEMC, REDEMG, REOGN2, REORGA, REORGC, REORGM – will be retired by <b>December 2015</b> . All Participants wishing to receive systemic announcements from DTC must be migrated to ISO 20022.
<b>2014-2015 - Redemption and Reorg phases begin</b>
The Redemption and Reorganization phases of CA Transformation will begin in 2014 and 2015, respectively. Retirement dates of PTS/PBS and CCF files for full lifecycle processing of these event groups will be announced in the near future.
