**As announced in Important Notice B# 0274 dated March 20, 2013, the enhanced MMI Tracking function is now available in the Settlement Web, and will be retired in Participant Terminal System (PTS) and the Participant Browser Service (PBS) on June 3, 2013.**

As with all functionality in the Settlement Web, access is governed by a user's role in the Customer Registration Service (CRS). MMI Tracking is governed by "Sensitive Function 8 – IPA Inquiry Privileges. Users needing access to the service should contact their Settlement Web access coordinator.
