

DTCC MQ Page 1 Instructions

The DTCC MQ Page 1 form is used to:

- Request a NEW MQ channel
- Modify an existing MQ channel (e.g: change an IP address or local receive queue name)
- Delete an existing MQ channel

The DTCC MQ Page 1 is designed as a Microsoft Word Form. Use the tab key to move from field to field. Some fields present the available choices as DROP DOWN lists. All fields are mandatory. Below is an explanation of each field.

Function: Choose ADD for new channel, CHANGE to modify an existing channel, DELETE to permanently remove an existing MQ channel

Environment: Choose PROD for a production channel, UAT for a test channel

Participant Number: The unique participant number assigned to you. It is used in naming channel and queues, and is required to process the request. If you don't know your participant number, contact your Relation Manager for help.

MBS Account Symbol: Optional for MBSCC channel requests only! Enter the four character alpha symbol code.

Company Name: Please fill in the company information

MQ Support Contact: The primary technical contact used during the installation and testing process

After Hours Operations Contact: The person or area DTCC will contact in the event this channel experience problems. It is very important this contact is correct!

Customer Environment/System Platform: A drop down, please choose the platform your channels will be running on. This information is required for the DTCC-side channel definitions to be complete and correct

Networking: Supply the TCP/IP address and port number which your sender channel will be presenting to DTCC. This address will also be used as the address defined in the DTCC sender channel to you.

D/R Networking Note: DTCC does not support unique channels for disaster recovery. If you wish to present us with a d/r IP address different from your 'normal' IP, enter it in the alternate IP address fields. Note the DTCC sender address to you will always remain the primary address! DTCC will *not* change a channel IP in the event of a d/r scenario!

Application: A drop down list. Please choose the application you will be using this channel to connect to.

Local Receive Queue Name: Specifies the queue on your side where the DTCC application will write our response to you.
