As a reminder to all Participants:

- On Friday December 22, 2017, an authorized representative must be available via the normal contact channels until their DTC and Canadian Dollar settlement account balances are settled.
- On Tuesday December 26, 2017, there will be no Canadian Dollar Settlement service in observance of Boxing Day in Canada.

Participants should be advised of the following:

- A. <u>Deposits</u>: Continuous Net Settlement (CNS) Deposits received in the night drop on Friday, December 22, 2017 will be available for credit toward CNS settlement obligations on Tuesday, December 26, 2017. **DTC will not provide record date protection on deposits made in the night drop on Friday, December 22, 2017.**
- B. <u>DTC Night Delivery Orders</u> (NDO) submitted on Friday December 22, 2017 will be processed for settlement on Tuesday, December 26, 2017.
- C. <u>Inventory Management System (IMS) Exemptions</u>: Should be submitted on Friday, December 22, 2017 for settlement date of Tuesday, December 27, 2016.
- D. Requests for Withdrawal-by-Transfers (WT): To avoid dividend problems, you are reminded to exclude any securities that are of record on Monday, December 25, 2017 from your submissions of WTs made by PTS/PBS on Friday December 22, 2017 or by CCF prior to the 8:30 A.M. cut-off on Friday December 22, 2017.
- E. <u>The Participant Browser Services (PBS)</u>, the <u>Participant Terminal System (PTS)</u> and the <u>Settlement Web (SW)</u> will **not** be available on Monday, December 25, 2017 for limited processing.
- F. Canadian Dollar Settlement (CDL): There will be no Canadian Dollar Settlement service on Tuesday, December 26, 2017 in observance of Boxing Day in Canada.
