On July 25, 2017, National Securities Clearing Corporation ("NSCC") filed a proposed rule change filing (SR-NSCC-2017-013) ("Rule Filing") with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") proposing to adopt the Clearing Agency Operational Risk Management Framework. This Rule Filing describes the manner in which NSCC manages operational risk, which is defined in the Framework as the risk of direct or indirect loss or reputational harm resulting from an event, internal or external, that is the result of inadequate or failed processes, people, and systems. No changes are being proposed to current processes.
