SUBJECT: NSCC PROPOSED RULE CHANGE – CLARIFY AND ENHANCE THE
CNS REORGANIZATION PROCESSING SYSTEM AND AUTHORITY TO
REVEAL IDENTITIES OF COUNTERPARTIES

On July 9, 2018, National Securities Clearing Corporation (“NSCC”) filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-2017-003) (“Rule Filing”) with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”). The Filing proposed to clarify and enhance rules related to the CNS Reorganization Processing System and NSCC’s authority to reveal identities of counterparties in certain circumstances, as described in greater detail in the Rule Filing. These enhancements are effective immediately.
