## Participants should be advised of the following:

- A. <u>Deposits</u>: Continuous Net Settlement (CNS) Deposits received in the night drop on Friday, August 30, 2019 will be available for credit toward CNS settlement obligations on Tuesday, September 3, 2019. **DTC will not provide record date protection on deposits made in the night drop on Friday, August 30, 2019.**
- B. <u>DTC Night Delivery Orders</u> (NDO) submitted on Friday, August 30, 2019 will be processed for settlement on Tuesday, September 3, 2019.
- C. <u>Inventory Management System (IMS) Exemptions</u>: Should be submitted on Friday, August 30, 2019 for settlement date on Tuesday, September 3, 2019.
- D. Requests for Withdrawal-by-Transfers (WT): To avoid dividend problems, you are reminded to exclude any securities that are of record on Monday, September 2, 2019 from your submissions of WTs made by PTS/PBS on Friday, August 30, 2019 or by CCF prior to the 8:30 A.M. cut-off on Friday, August 30, 2019.
- E. The Participant Browser Services (PBS), the Participant Terminal System (PTS) and the Settlement Web (SW) will **not** be available on Monday, September 2, 2019.
- F. <u>Canadian Dollar Settlement (CDL):</u> There will be no Canadian Dollar Settlement services provided on Monday, September 2, 2019.
