

Standard Usage for Customer Account Transfer to Carrier (CAT – Output to Carrier) Transaction (ACATS)

3/24/05

(see Change Log at the end for changes since last version)

CAT Transaction is used to in conjunction with ACATS to provide the Insurance Carrier with the broker/dealer change information generated in the ACATS system. The CAT (output to Carrier) is only created by IPS from the information it received via ACATS. The information from ACATS is based on the ACATS Insurance Registration (IR) record sent by the Receiving firm to the ACATS system.

Listed are the fields applicable to the CAT transaction. Fields not listed are not used for this transaction will not be sent to the Carrier.

If the DTCC edit column states R (Required), then this field is always sent by IPS to the Carrier.

If the DTCC edit column states O (Optional), then it is Optional on the ACATS IR record.

If the DTCC edit column states C (Conditional), then this field will be sent under conditions indicated in the Notes column.

Fields in 73-10, 73-12, 73-13, 73-20, 73-22 and 73-23 are dependent on whether the record is included in the CAT transaction. Here are the guidelines for when each these records would be included:

73-10 – Always sent if Insurance Transfer Type (ITT) is 02, 03 or 04 and will never be sent for 01.

73-12 – Always sent if ITT is 02 or 04. Will only be sent if provided by ACATS for 03 and will never be sent for 01.

73-13 - Will always be sent if ITT is 02, 03 or 04 and will never be sent for 01.

73-20 – Will always be sent if ITT is 02, 03 or 04 and will never be sent for 01

73-22 - Will only be sent if provided by ACATS for 03 (record is optional for 03) and will never be sent for 01.

73-23 - Will only be sent if provided by ACATS for 03 (record is optional for 03) and will never be sent for 01.
