The **Modernized Continuous Net Settlement System (CNS)** will deliver a more advanced, resilient platform for clearing. It will include key simplifications and enhancements (see list to right) as well as modernized client interfaces. Additional Clearing enhancements will be delivered in parallel.

Key Client Testing & Activities leading up to Go-live:

Client Profile Migrations

- Clients can begin to migrate NSCC Exemptions Level 1 to Inventory Management Delivery Authorization beginning in Q3 2025. This migration does not need to be completed by Q4 2026 – a later date will be determined and communicated.
- NSCC Level 2 Exemptions are scheduled to be decommissioned in Q3 2025.
- Fully-Paid-For Account is scheduled to be decommissioned in Q3 2025.

Client Interfaces & Testing

Clients will have several options to test new connectivity, client interfaces and functionality leading up to Q4 2026. DTCC will develop and share industry test plans in Q3 2025.

Current connectivity will be decommissioned in Q4 2026 (more information will be provided in Q2 to support this). However, current transactional input / output formats will NOT be decommissioned in Q4 2026 – a later date will be determined and communicated.



The **Modernized Inventory Management System** will deliver a more advanced, resilient platform for settlement processing. It will include key simplifications and enhancements (see list to right) as well as modernized client interfaces.

Go-live in Q3 2027

Key Client Testing & Activities leading up to Go-live:

Client Profile Migrations

(Clients can be provided with their profile configurations and instructions to assist in the migration)

Beginning in Q3 2025

- Clients have the option to update their profiles for *Deliverer Authorization & RAD Approval* in the existing system to realize modernized system target state behavior. Profiles must be updated prior to Q3 2027 go live.
- Clients can begin to migrate NSCC Exemptions Level 1 to Inventory Management Delivery Authorization. **This migration does not need to be completed by Q3 2027** a later date will be determined and communicated.
- Clients can also migrate from color profiles to existing default and FIFO option to realize modernized system target state behavior for *Pend Processing & Recycling*. Profiles must be updated prior to Q3 2027 go live.

Client Interfaces & Testing

Clients will have several options to test new connectivity, client interfaces and functionality for the Modernized Inventory Management leading up to Q3 2027. DTCC will develop and share industry test plans in Q3 2025.

Current connectivity and transactional input / output formats will be decommissioned in Q3 2027 (more information will be provided in the form of message specifications through Q2 2025):

- > ISO20022 Simulator (this allows you to submit an ISO20022 message to check format, schema issues prior to UAT being available) available Q1 2026
- ➤ Connectivity Testing (PSE) Starting Q2 2026
- Connectivity Testing (PROD) Starting Q3 2026
- ➤ UAT / Functional (PSE) Starting Q3 2026


