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#### Amendment No. 1 to SR-FICC-2023-012

Fixed Income Clearing Corporation ("FICC") is filing this partial amendment ("Amendment No. 1") to SR-FICC-2023-012 ("Proposed Rule Change"), which was filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") on August 3, 2023.

The Proposed Rule Change consists of modifications to FICC's Government Securities Division ("GSD") Rulebook ("GSD Rules") and Mortgage-Backed Securities Division ("MBSD") Clearing Rules ("MBSD Rules") and proposes to (1) enhance the calculation of the Margin Liquidity Adjustment Charge ("MLA Charge") in the GSD Rules for Sponsored Members that clear through multiple accounts sponsored by multiple Sponsoring Members, (2) revise the language in the GSD Rules and MBSD Rules describing the asset groups/subgroups used in the calculation of the MLA Charge at GSD and MBSD, respectively, and (3) clarify the language in the GSD Rules and MBSD Rules describing the calculation of the MLA Charge at GSD and MBSD, as well as make technical changes in the GSD Rules.
