In Important Notice A#7556, P&S# 7126 dated December 21, 2012, the National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC) described the requirements for the CNS ACATS and DTC settling assets project.

This Notice announces the publication of the record layouts for the new files that ACATS will create to inform participants of their exited and failed non-CNS DTC ACATS obligations.

ACATS will produce the following new files and instructions: CNS ACATS Ineligible Security Reject File, CNS ACATS Ineligible Security Receive and Deliver Instructions, CNS ACATS End of Day (EOD) Fail File, CNS ACATS EOD Fail Receive and Deliver Instructions.

Below is a table that lists the names of the files, and their Autoroute numbers in both the testing and production environments.
