Subject:	DTCC Portal 2 Factor Authentication

On October 10, 2015, The National Securities Clearing Corporation (“NSCC”) will enforce 2 factor authentication for all NSCC Portal applications accessed via the following URL: <https://portal.dtcc.com>. This change may impact users of the following products:

- SMART/Track for Buy-Ins
- SMART/Track for CNS Corporate Actions
- CA Liability Notices (CALN)
- Obligation Warehouse
- DTCC Limit Monitoring
- Insurance Producer Management Web

What does this mean?

Beginning October 10, some users may experience the following immediately after logging into the portal:

- Receive an alert on their screen notifying them that their computer is not recognized and prompting them to enter an Activation code.
- The Activation code will be automatically delivered to the user’s registered e-mail address.
- The user enters the Activation Code, which registers his computer and redirects him to the Portal main page.

Going forward, the user will only be prompted to enter an activation code when logging in from a new computer or after deleting his or her browser history.
