The National Securities Clearing Corporation ("NSCC") proposed rule change <u>File Number SR-NSCC-2019-003</u> pursuant to Rule 19b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 was approved by the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") on December 09, 2019. NSCC created a Client Cybersecurity Program to ensure that all its Members have implemented a cybersecurity program designed from a recognized security framework so that such Member's SMART network and/or other connectivity is adequately protected against cybersecurity risks.

As part of the rule implementation, each NSCC Members' designated Control Officer (a senior executive that is accountable for overseeing The Company's cybersecurity program) will receive a DocuSign electronic Confirmation Form on **July 13, 2020** sent by NSCC and will be given **183 days** to adhere to the cybersecurity requirements of NSCC. As proof of compliance, the Control Officer of each NSCC Member must **digitally sign** and submit the Confirmation Form **via DocuSign** no later than **January 12, 2021**. As defined in the rule, Members identified as being non-compliant may be subject to a fine.

Please take note that NSCC will only accept digitally signed confirmation. Printed confirmations or manually signed confirmation forms will not be accepted.

In addition to the initial Client Cybersecurity Confirmation form, each Member will be required to sign an updated Confirmation form once every two years from the time the form was initially sent.
