Subject:	Decommission of HTTP for PBS and Settlement Web Access

DTCC currently allows clients to access its Participant Browser Service (PBS) and Settlement Web user interfaces over unencrypted HTTP (port 80) and encrypted HTTPS (port 443). To ensure the continued security of its user interfaces, on September 12, 2020, DTCC will retire access via HTTP (port 80) for all clients accessing PBS and the Settlement. After September 12th, all client access to the PBS and Settlement Web user interfaces must be over HTTPS (port 443).

To prevent loss of user access to PBS and the Settlement Web, clients should immediately contact their IT and network teams to ensure that all of their IP addresses connecting to PBS and the Settlement Web are open to HTTPS (port 443) prior to September 12th, 2020.
