On February 6, 2023, Fixed Income Clearing Corporation (“FICC”) filed a proposed rule change SR-FICC-2023-002 (“Rule Filing”) with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) pursuant to Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, and Rule 19b-4(f)(6) thereunder. The purpose of the Rule Filing is to improve the transparency of the rules describing the Sponsored Clearing service by making clarifications, corrections, and technical changes to the FICC Government Securities Division (“GSD”) Rulebook (“Rules”).
