<b>Subject:</b>	NSCC Proposed Rule Change – Updates to NSCC Rules to Decommission the DTCC Limit Monitoring Risk Management Tool (SR-NSCC-2024-004)

On May 16, 2024, National Securities Clearing Corporation (“NSCC”) filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-2024-004) (“Rule Filing”) with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) pursuant to Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended. The Rule Filing would modify the NSCC Rules & Procedures (“NSCC Rules”) to decommission the DTCC Limit Monitoring risk management tool (“Limit Monitoring”). To implement the proposed change, NSCC would remove Rule 54 and Procedure XVII from the NSCC Rules and make other conforming changes to the NSCC Rules to reflect the decommissioning of Limit Monitoring.

The proposed rule change would be implemented on November 15, 2024, subject to approval by the SEC.
