<b>Subject:</b>	<b>UPDATE:</b> FICC Report Center Web Application Modernization

**Please note: The original deadlines for the FICC Report Center Modernization have been extended.**

The new key dates are as follows:

- The deadline to migrate and confirm access to the modernized FICC Report Center application is now **Friday, March 13, 2026** (previously January 16, 2026).
- Access to the legacy FICC Report Center application will now be decommissioned on **Friday, March 27, 2026** (previously January 30, 2026).
- The legacy FICC Report Center application will not be accessible to Members effective **Monday, March 30, 2026** (previously February 2, 2026).

**Action Required: All FICC-GSD Members must migrate to the modernized FICC Report Center application and confirm access by Friday, March 13, 2026. Access to the legacy FICC Report Center application will be decommissioned on Friday, March 27, 2026.**

This modernization effort moved FICC Report Center to a new platform with a new authentication layer and URL. The Government Securities Division (“GSD”) of the Fixed Income Clearing Corporation (“FICC”) has client resources and requirements regarding the FICC Report Center migration in Important Notices [GOV2023-25](#) and [GOV2036-25](#). User Acceptance Testing (UAT) and production parallel access have been available to Members since October 20, 2025. Access to the legacy FICC Report Center application is scheduled to be decommissioned on **Friday, March 27, 2026**.

While some FICC-GSD Members have taken steps to migrate to the modernized FICC Report Center application, **all GSD Members are required** to do so and confirm their access to the new FICC Report Center application.

Such Members are reminded that upgrading the network technology by the time specified by FICC-GSD is an ongoing membership requirement under the FICC-GSD Rules. Specifically, Members who fail to complete UAT and migrate to the modernized application will be in violation of FICC-GSD Rule 3, Section 2; Rule 3A, Section 2(e); and Rule 3B, Section 5(b)(i), as applicable to that Member, which requires that Members upgrade their network technology by the time specified by FICC-GSD.

## **Immediate Actions to migrate to the new FICC Report Center application and Maintain Compliance:**

1. Users should download the [FICC Member Network Connectivity Options for RTTM Web guide](#) available on the DTCC Learning Center. Users must have login credentials to the DTCC Learning Center to access the guide.
2. Users should verify their access to the new FICC Report Center URLs for both the UAT and production environments. This may require a Domain Name System (“DNS”) configuration of the new URLs to your network.
3. Upon verification of access, a representative from each impacted firm must send an email to the [FICC Integration team](#) stating they have successfully accessed the new FICC Report Center URLs along with the associated accounts they represent.
4. Verification of access must be submitted to the [FICC Integration team](#) no later than **Friday, March 13, 2026**. This verification must be provided by **all** Member firms irrespective of whether a DNS configuration is needed to connect to the new URLs.

### **Please note the following:**

- Users should access the new URLs through Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge. Users should **not** use alternative web browsers to access the new URLs.
- Please refer to the [FICC Member Network Connectivity Options for RTTM Web guide](#) for information on how to reconfigure your network to access the new FICC Report Center URLs.
- A new FICC Report Center tile has been added to the MyDTCC Portal for easy access to the new application. The tile is labeled ***FICC Report Center (New)***.
- Access to the legacy FICC Report Center application will be available in production parallel until **Friday, March 27, 2026**.
- Effective on **Monday, March 30, 2026**, the legacy FICC Report Center application will not be accessible to Members.

To avoid fines and any interruptions in Report Center access, it is imperative that Members complete testing and migrate to the modernized FICC Report Center application by **Friday, March 13, 2026**.
