Subject:	GSD Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery – Testing Schedule

The Government Securities Division of the Fixed Income Clearing Corporation ("FICC/GSD") is providing an update regarding the 2026 Regulation Systems Compliance and Integrity ("Reg SCI") testing program and previously communicated requirements on participating firms.

Update to 2026 Reg SCI Rule 1004(b) Testing Requirements

As previously communicated, the industry-wide Reg SCI exercise remains scheduled for Saturday, October 24, 2026. However, the participation requirements for designated FICC/GSD firms have changed.

FICC/GSD will conduct a planned data center rotation event on October 17, 2026, transitioning operations from its primary data center to its backup data center. As a result, designated firms will transition to operating in FICC/GSD's live production environment at the backup data center during the week of October 19, 2026. FICC/GSD will use the results of this production activity to validate designated firms' connectivity and operational readiness at the backup data center.

Accordingly, designated firms that received prior notifications requiring participation in the October 24, 2026, Reg SCI industry exercise will no longer be required to actively participate on the October 24 test date. Because connectivity and operational readiness will be demonstrated through live production activity following the October 17 data center rotation, separate participation in the October 24 exercise will not be required.

To support firms' regulatory and compliance obligations, FICC/GSD will make available a report during the week of October 26, 2026, confirming the results of these activities for designated firms.

SMART Network Connectivity Testing Requirement

Notwithstanding the changes described above, designated FICC/GSD firms utilizing the SMART Network remain required to perform annual connectivity testing between their alternate locations and DTCC data centers. These firms will be contacted by DTCC in August regarding testing coordination for the 2026 calendar year.

FICC/GSD firms that are not required to conduct a connectivity test are nevertheless encouraged to do so.

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Looking Ahead

DTCC will continue to evaluate its testing program and will communicate details regarding the 2027 Reg SCI testing schedule and requirements as they become available.
